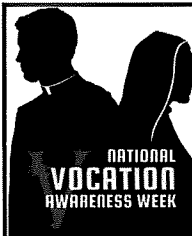

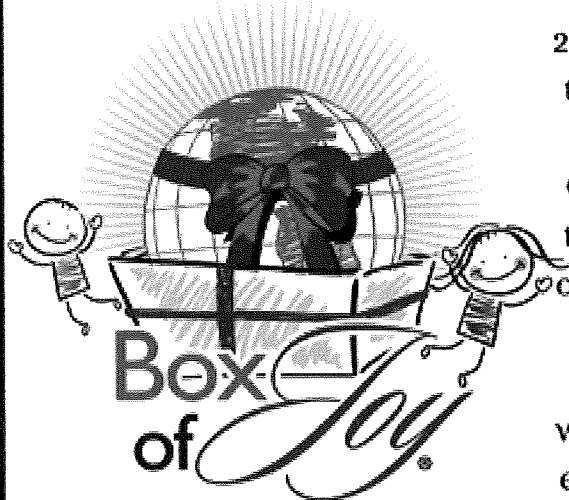
During this week, please encourage the young people in your life – children, grandchildren, students, and friends – to be open if God calls them to priesthood or religious life.
