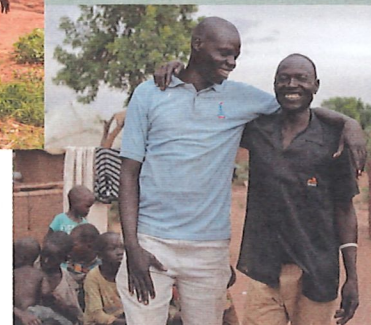
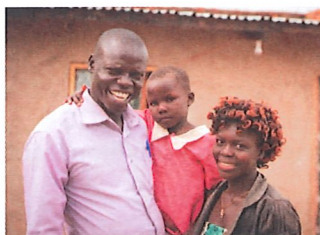
The Catholic Relief Services Collection is your opportunity to improve the lives of the most vulnerable people around the world and here in the United States. 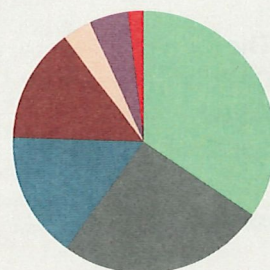
