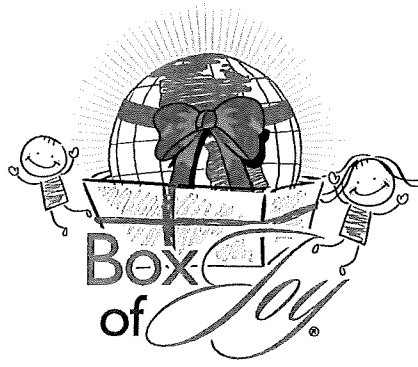
Gospel. We have set a goal to bless 110 impoverished children in Latin America!
